Take-away messages

Integration is a challenging *process*: never 'finished'

A tool is only as good as the data you put into it
...teams, assessments, M & E systems...

A methodology is only effective if you use outputs in
useful ways

...analysis, design, planning, monitoring, and
communication (inter-agency, host governments,
contractors, etc)

Take away messages

- You are not alone! There is internal and external expertise...
- Ongoing conversations on integration within USAID
- Integration, conflict prevention and environmental sustainability demand significant investments
- ...but they bring long-term, multi-dimensional results
- Good integration is good development!
